## Why You Should Enroll In The Tank-Guard® Program

Like everything else, the cost to replace a leaking oil tank has risen over the past few years. *Today, oil tank replacement (including disposal of the old tank) can easily cost from \$1,500 to over \$2,000.*

We are pleased to tell you that our Tank-Guard® Program offers the best oil tank protection available. This is a proactive program that includes protecting the inside of your tank with a liquid corrosion inhibitor and also gives you a comprehensive warranty that will provide a FREE TANK REPLACEMENT if your tank leaks from internal corrosion.

The Free Tank Replacement includes the disposal of the old tank. The cost for permits and any required current safety code upgrades will be extra, as described below.

*Most homeowner insurance does not cover oil tanks.* The best way to protect your tank is to sign up now for our Tank-Guard® Program. It costs only \$34.95 (plus tax) per year. You'll get peace of mind for just pennies a day, and you could save \$1,500 or more!

Your oil tank is eligible for enrollment if it has not been repaired at any time, is not leaking now and meets safety standards. Underground tanks and tanks of more than 330 gallons capacity are not eligible. Once you enroll your tank we will renew the protection annually unless we are notified otherwise.

The warranty benefit is limited to the tank replacement and does not extend to environment cleanup. New tanks will be installed in accordance with safety codes. Costs for permits and some safety code upgrades (if required) will be extra. The TANK-GUARD® corrosion inhibitor and warranty are provided by Lincoln Laboratory, a company which has served the Oil Heat Industry for over 45 years. Complete warranty details are available on reverse.

## **TANK REPLACEMENT WARRANTY**

**Tank-Guard®** is backed by a solid tank replacement warranty. If you have a tank leak which is covered by the **Tank-Guard®** warranty, your oil tank will be replaced at no charge (parts and labor). Removal and certified disposal of your old tank and sludge is included.

Your oil tank is a vital component of your heating system and is worth protecting. With this warranty, the **Tank-Guard®** Program offers the most complete tank protection available.

Oil leaks can be serious, so please check your oil tank regularly and call your oil dealer (CAPE ANN OIL INCORPORATED) immediately at the first sign of any leak.

## **TANK-GUARD® ANNUAL LIMITED WARRANTY**

When your eligible above ground heating oil tank (maximum capacity of 330 gallons) is treated with TANK-GUARD®, Lincoln Laboratory, PO Box 381, Leicester, MA 01524, the manufacture of TANK-GUARD® provides the following limited warranty for one year from the date of invoicing: if during this period your aboveground tank leaks from internal corrosion which Tank-Guard® has failed to prevent, you will be eligible to receive a new standard single wall replacement tank per the details below. Leak verification is required.

1. Bond-Tite Tank Service (a division of Lincoln Laboratory) will replace the tank and Lincoln Laboratory will pay for the NEW TANK INSTALLATION and for the OLD TANK REMOVAL. The fireomatic valve, tank gauge and vent alarm will also be replaced if needed. New fill or vent piping (up to 20 feet) and new oil supply line (up to 35 feet), if required by safety codes, will also be included.
2. The costs for other changes required by current safety codes (such as double wall tanks, protective diking or barriers, cement pads, etc.), relocating the tank, difficult access or other unusual circumstances will be billed to you. You will be responsible for providing access to a tank which has been enclosed or built in, or where there is not adequate clearance to move the tanks in or out of the building. Permit charges are not included and will be billed to you.
3. If you or your oil dealer (CAPE ANN OIL INCORPORATED) choose another method of replacing your oil tank, you will be allowed a flat rate reimbursement from Lincoln Laboratory. Leak verification by your oil dealer (CAPE ANN OIL INCORPORATED) prior to replacement and proof of replacement with a new tank is required. Your oil dealer (CAPE ANN OIL INCORPORATED) will tell you the current flat rate reimbursement amount. Any costs in excess of this amount will be your responsibility.

## **WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS**

The above is your exclusive remedy. Leaking tanks, tanks which have been repaired and under ground tanks are not eligible and are excluded. Costs for emergency response services are excluded. LINCOLN LABORATORY HAS NO LIABILITY FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUPS OR FOR ANY OTHER INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES. TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THERE IS NO WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR OTHER IMPLIED WARRANTY. Any claim for breach of warranties must be brought during the one year warranty period or within 90 days thereafter. Some states do not allow certain limitations on implied warranties or the exclusion of incidental or consequential damages or the exclusion of the warranty of merchantability, so the above limitations and exclusions may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

Other leaks can pose serious safety and environmental hazards, so we recommend that you check your oil tank regularly and call your oil dealer at the first sign of a tank leak.
